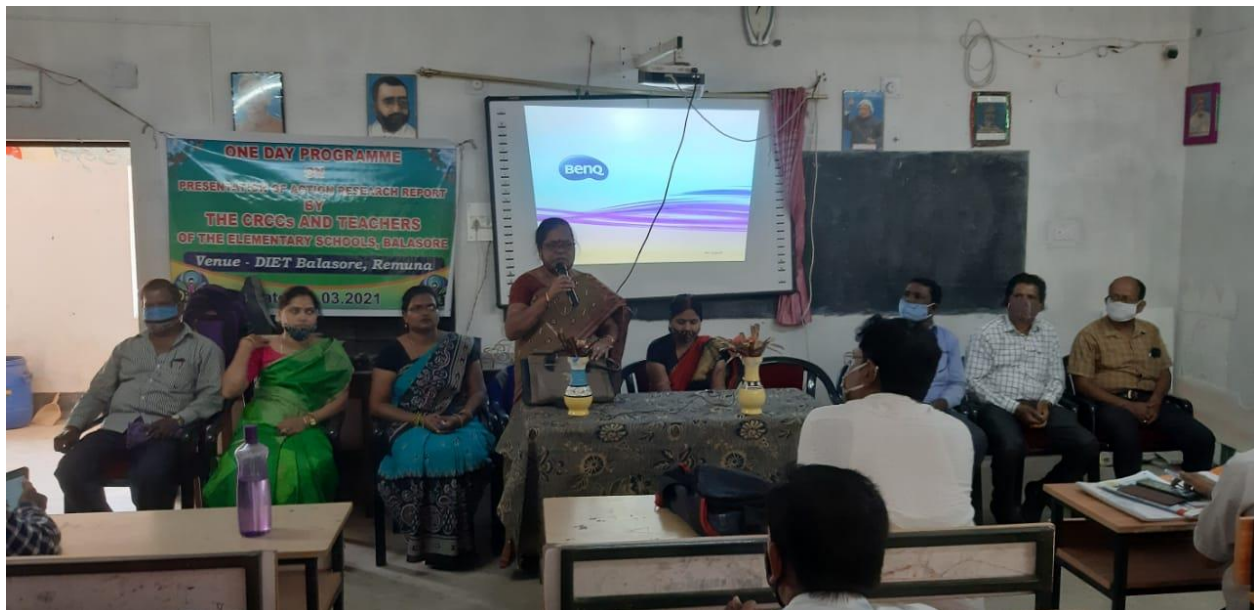

Action research in the field of education can find answers of the questions that are unknown, bridge the gap in knowledge and change the way that professionals work in the field of education Action research introduces actions/interventions based on enquiries conducted within specific and often practical contest in education



So DIET Balasore has been organising Action research program in different elementary schools of Balasore district :

- To solve the problem in Teaching-Learning process of the school

- To develop the required confidence and ability of teachers to carry out Action research for solving the problems in the Teaching-Learning process of the schools
