Two days workshop of zonal level sharing of sharing NAS Report Cards - 2017 organized by DIET, Puri, during 25th & 26th June, 2018 at Hotel Landmark, Puri. Principal and all the faculties of DIET, Puri, Nayagarh, Khorda, Kandhamal and Khalikote were participated in the workshop. Pedagogy Coordinators of these 05v districts were attended the programme. Total 60 no of participants were sensitized on NAS results.



The programme was started by 9.00 AM. Mr Hrushikesh Behera, Principal Puri given introduction of all resource persons followed by introduction of all participants. Mr. Kartika Chandrta Dash, Additional Director Planning, OPEPA and Ms Nandita Manjari Rath, NAS Coordinator were

present and gave introductory speech about NAS and different component of NAS 2017.



Tapas Kumar Nayak, Asst Director, TE & SCERT, briefed the participants about the need and requirement to arrange the zonal level sharing of NAS workshop to all Teacher Educators and all stakeholders and shared the impact of NAS towards students, teachers and Teacher Educators.

The days first session was started by Mr. Prasanta Kumar Rath, Sr. TE, DIET, Dolipur,

he discussed about role of DIET in NAS. Further Sri Tapas Kumar Nayak, discussed about requirement of post NAS intervention, features of NAS, State report cards and district report cards. He has discussed about the features of NAS 2017 and how it was different from NAS 2002. He also discussed about U-DISE (Unified District Information system), PISA (Programme of international student assessment).



The second session was lead by Sri Tapas Kumar Nayak on Learning outcomes. Learning Outcomes are statements that describe significant and essential learning that learners have achieved and can demonstrate it at the end of a chapter /course/period of time. He deliberated that LOs (Learning outcomes) are helpful to clarify the expectations for students, evaluate the teaching strategies (Materials, approaches) and Re-assess teachers' assessment.



The after lunch session was started by Prasanta Kumar Rath.

He discussed about state report cards. He discussed on the following points in the workshop:

- Why state report cards
- Different components of state report cards

- Analysis of state report cards
- Districts below the national average
- Analysis at TQ, PQ & SQ
- Use at state report card by different level

Then the fourth session was continued by Tapas Kumar Nayak and the discussion was about purpose of preparation of state report cards which gives idea about health status of education system of India, i.e. Level of our school, students; present status of schools etc. the first day programme came to an end with some assignments for evening work i.e.



- Reading and understanding the learning out comes
- Analysis of state report card in different angle
- Analysis of Dist. Report cards in different angle.



The second days' first session was started by Sri Prasanta Kumar Rath. He briefed about the first day discussions and test knowledge gained by participants about state report cards and district report cards. The Director TE & SCERT, Odisha, discussed with participants about NAS sharing of report cards in the workshop.

He discussed on-

- How questions were prepared?
- What is the use of NAS findings?
- How to read the state & District report cards?

The Director TE & SCERT inspired the participants to use & re-use of NAS findings. In the meantime Additional Director, Planning and in charge officer, NAS of OPEPA came and discussed about the process of NAS 2017. He highlighted how DPC, DEO, Principal DIET and FIs were work jointly for the success of the NAS. last Mr. Nayak, pointed out that NAS week will be celebrated from 2dwee of August. All CRCCs will be trained on NAS findings and each DIET faculty member will be allowed o visit ne block to provide on state support to CRCC and teachers.

The post lunch session as continued by Tapas Kumar Nayak and he iscussion was abou planning for NAS activities and for preparation of learning outcomes which includes·

- PST (Pre service Training),
- Teacher capacity training,
- supplementary material prepare,
- extension activities,
- review of CRCCs,
- Research and documentation.
