Important notice for the applicants seeking admission into B.Ed./ B.H.Ed./M.Ed. Courses at State Public Universities and Colleges (Teacher Education Courses) participating under SAMS for the Academic Session 2025-26

It is for information of all concerned that admission into 2 year **B.Ed. /B.H.Ed. /M.Ed.** Courses for the HEIs participating under SAMS shall be done through an **Entrance test.** Accordingly, the candidates are hereby instructed to fill-up the Common Application Form by visiting the SAMS **portal** as per the timeline mentioned below.

N.B: Information Brochure for the said course is available on the SAMS portal. Please refer to the Information Brochure before filling up the CAF. The key points of e-Admission for the Academic Year 2025-26 are as follows.

- 1. In the current academic session, Phase-I admission will be conducted initially. Based on the availability of vacant seats, the Higher Education Department may consider conducting Phase-II or SPOT admissions later only for left out students.
- 2. The Phase-I admission will consists of 4 rounds of selection. In the 3rd round, the de-reservation of seats will be carried out in absence of the eligible applicants of a specific category. In the last round (4th round), if vacancy arises, a waiting list admission round will be conducted.
- 3. From the AY: 2025-26, counselling based online admission will be implemented in the aforementioned T.E. Courses. For Applicants who got a seat in a round are advised to choose one of the following options

<u>Freeze</u>: - If an applicant is satisfied with the allotted HEI, S/he can choose this option. After selecting the "Freeze" option, applicants have to pay the admission fees for that seat allocated. The required fees will be shown in the screen and s/he has to pay the fees in online mode only. The applicants who will choose the "Freeze" option can download the Intimation Letter and have to visit the selected HEIs to complete the admission formalities.

<u>Slide</u>: - If an applicant has accepted the allotted seat but also wants for his/her higher preferences, s/he can choose this option. After selecting the "Slide" option, applicants have to pay the admission fees for that seat allocated. The required fees will be shown in the screen and s/he has to pay the fees in online mode only. However, such applicants need not have to visit the allocated HEIs, as they will not get the Intimation Letter and they will wait for the subsequent round of selection.

4. Whenever a seat is allocated, applicants are compulsorily required to choose one of the option - Freeze or Slide - carefully. If the applicant will not choose any of the options that implies the applicant is rejecting the offered/allocated seat and s/he will be out of the counselling process for the subsequent rounds of that Phase. The detail process of "Freeze" & "Slide" is mentioned in the Information Brochure available on the SAMS portal.

- 5. While applying for the CAF for 2 years B.Ed., B.H.Ed. & M.Ed. Courses, applicants are advised to check the Eligibility Criteria for each course mentioned in the Information Brochure available on the SAMS portal.
- 6. The candidates, whose final U.G. results are awaited (not published), can also apply on-line in the CAF to appear the Entrance Examination. But they must upload their marks and provide their preference of HEIs (Choice Locking) by logging into the "Existing Students Login" as per the timeline fixed by the Higher Education department.
- 7. For this Academic Year, applicants wish to be considered for scholarship from the Higher Education Department must upload the **Residence**, **Income & Caste Certificates** while filling up the CAF. Hence, they are advised to keep ready the required certificates in well advance before filling up the CAF. If the applicants fail to upload the certificates during filling up the CAF, another chance will be given to upload the certificates during choice filling timeline and updation of graduation marks.
- 8. For the academic session 2025-26, the admission process for 2-year B.Ed., B.H.Ed., and M.Ed. courses will start early, irrespective of the declaration of final results. However, applicants whose results are not declared during the admission period must submit their graduation or equivalent certificate to their respective institutions within two months of admission. If students fail to provide the required certificates within two months from the date of admission or their final marks do not meet the eligibility criteria specified in the Information Brochure, their admission will be cancelled by the concerned University/ College. Further, those seat can be allotted to others eligible applicants.
